

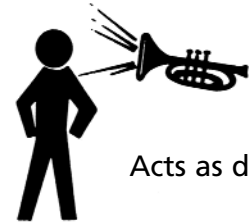
## Possible Signs of Autism



Resists normal teaching methods



Inappropriate laughing or giggling



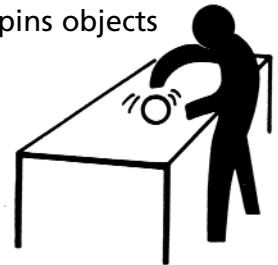
Acts as deaf

Apparent insensitivity to pain



Echolalic

Spins objects



No fear of real dangers

Crying, tantrums



Extreme distress for no discernible reason



Sustained odd play



Not cuddly



Difficulty in mixing with other children



Resists change in routine



No eye contact



Stand-offish manner



Uneven gross/fine motor skills  
May not want to kick ball but can stack blocks



Inappropriate attachment to objects



Marked physical overactivity or extreme passivity
